Answers to City of London Federal Election Candidate Questionnaire

Leonard VanderHoeven. My answers are my own and are not party policy.

1. A very important politician says on page one of the London Free Press of Tuesday, September 23, 'frankly you can not rehabilitate someone unless you drive home to them the seriousness of their crimes' so my comments will be harsh. Abortion has killed over three million innocent unborn babies at the annual rate of 100,000 or an average of 300 a day. Abortion is a heinous crime that destroys the future of Canada and I consider it as bad as treason. Any municipality that promotes Abortion with propaganda or defends Abortion with police or has an active Abortion facility within its boundaries, will have no say in the design or implementation of federal programs and will receive no federal money. A municipality that is not an Abortion enabler will get an equal seat at the discussion table. This restriction based on Abortion applies to all seventeen questions.
2. The Bank of Canada will be instructed to make interest free loans to municipalities for Infrastructure projects. These facilities provide access to resources and to markets and the increased economic activity will enable the borrowers to quickly repay the loans. This plan was a success when it reduced unemployment and brought long lasting prosperity after World War Two.
3. A national Transit strategy depends on the willingness of citizens to prefer public buses and trains over other modes. The clearly indicated preference of the average citizen is the private car. Incentives for car pooling would be the most popular environment friendly solution. A Transit project must come with proof that people will use it and explain in exact detail, including the tax incentives required, why they will continue to use it.
4. Our housing program would use the Infrastructure program to finance needed low cost rental housing, revive the CMHC's Co Op Housing program and revise the building code to allow the construction of simple starter homes designed to grow with a family.
5. Municipalities that succeed or fail in the environmental agenda will be used as examples and test cases for others and will be rewarded accordingly. The major polluter is the generation of electricity with dirty coal. Engineers will be assigned the task of designing the clean burning of lower grades of coal. Wind mills and solar panels will generate clean energy and hybrid cars will reduce air pollution.
6. Community Safety and Policing Programs will be improved with laws that make criminals face the consequences of their actions. The Young Offenders Act will be revised so that adults cannot exploit the young to commit criminal offences at very low risk of penalties. When a sexual assault occurs now, the male gets a light sentence if convicted and the innocent child is killed by Abortion. Our plans will give the male a heavy sentence if convicted and the innocent child will live. Restitution to victims will be an integral part of the justice system.
7. Immigrants require help with English as a second language and must be prepared to accept and respect Canadian Common Law. Immigration statistics will be a matter of public record and communities compensated for their work with immigrants. The most important newcomer that the community needs to attract, retain and integrate is the baby in the womb.

8. Children are worse off on a variety of behavioural and health dimensions, ranging from aggression to motor social skills to illness, when they are removed from their parents. We will pay \$1,000 a month for stay at home child care.
9. Poverty means that there is work to be done. Abortion has killed three million Canadians who would have built the homes and prepared the food to feed and house the poor. Canada has lost an army of workers and Abortion must stop now. We will move the focus of society and of government decision making, from the frills that the rich want to the needs that the poor have.
10. Arts and culture that are silent over forty years on the mass murder of Abortion, deserve zero financial support. No one today admires Nazi or Stalinist art and culture.
11. Thousands of ordinary people living in a city have little impact on parks and trails. The areas for natural recreation disappear when a small collection of rich old men decide to develop the area for their own selfish financial purposes. In other words only the rich have the power to destroy the environment and government must stop them. Money control and not population control, is the environmental answer.
12. Adults are designed to take care of children, and people exercise while doing work. When three million innocent unborn babies are removed from the adult work load, then obesity will increase. Stop Abortion.
13. The Canada Health Act will be amended to provide full protection for all age groups. The population is aging because the older generation has systematically eliminated the young. As a result almost all voters are old and the entire resources of the country are being used to buy the votes of old folks. Our top priority is care for the young. We should open the voting window at the age of fifteen and close it to people born before 1950 so that all groups have an equal opportunity to protect themselves. No upper age limit has been set on voting yet, because no one ever expected an older generation to hold on to political power by killing millions of their own children with Abortion.
14. We will review Ontario's Fairness Campaign to make sure that it is truly fair and a productive use of limited public resources. We will define the work that needs to be done to protect the life and liberty of all Canadians from conception in the womb to natural death.

16. High speed passenger trains compete with a fully developed road system that has the flexibility to start and stop the journey wherever people want it to. Before we build the trains we need to consider carefully why people would want to escape to Windsor or Quebec City from London.
17. We would make everyone aware that children are the future of the nation and that killing children kills Canada. I must comment on the tone of complete selfishness and 'what is in it for me?' that fills all seventeen City of London questions to overflowing. Does Canada owe everything to voters in London while London owes nothing to Canada?
