Dear Resident,

The City of London is hosting a **public meeting September 29, 2009 at the Huron University College, in their Kingsmill Room from 7:00-9:00 pm** to discuss a proposed pedestrian/cycling pathway connection across Medway Creek. This pathway would link the east end of Gainsborough Road to the western portion of Windermere Road through the Elsie Perrin Williams Estate and the Medway Valley Heritage Forest. A map outlining the anticipated alignment of this pathway and creek crossing has been included with this letter. A second map providing directions to the September 29 meeting location has also been included.

The purpose of the project is to establish a 3.0 meter wide asphalt pathway connection across the Medway Valley in an environmentally sustainable manner, to improve community connections and to support sustainable transportation choices and more active life styles for all residents.

At this Public Meeting, the City will provide the following information: why this project has been proposed, how its implementation can benefit the surrounding environmentally sensitive areas in Medway Valley and how the project benefits the surrounding community. City staff will also explain how the project, as currently planned, would be constructed. Following this presentation, the City will receive input from the public and answer questions. Input received at this meeting will be used to help refine the design of the project, but may ultimately influence whether the project proceeds, so please attend to voice your concerns or support for the project.
