- The MVHF ESA is a provincially and federally recognized, award winning example of best practices for the protection of ecological integrity, biodiversity and species at risk in an urban natural area.
- The CMP is available on the City website at London.ca/ESACMP and the environmental management strategy describes the proposed sustainable trail concept plan, and recommendations to continue the significant work on ecological restoration, monitoring, community engagement and education.
- The Council approved, Guidelines for Management Zones and Trails in ESAs for protection of ESA ecosystems has been followed.
- The proposed Conservation Master Plan complies with these Guidelines and protects the significant ecological features and functions of the ESA, while providing better access for all Londoners, as required by the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act.
