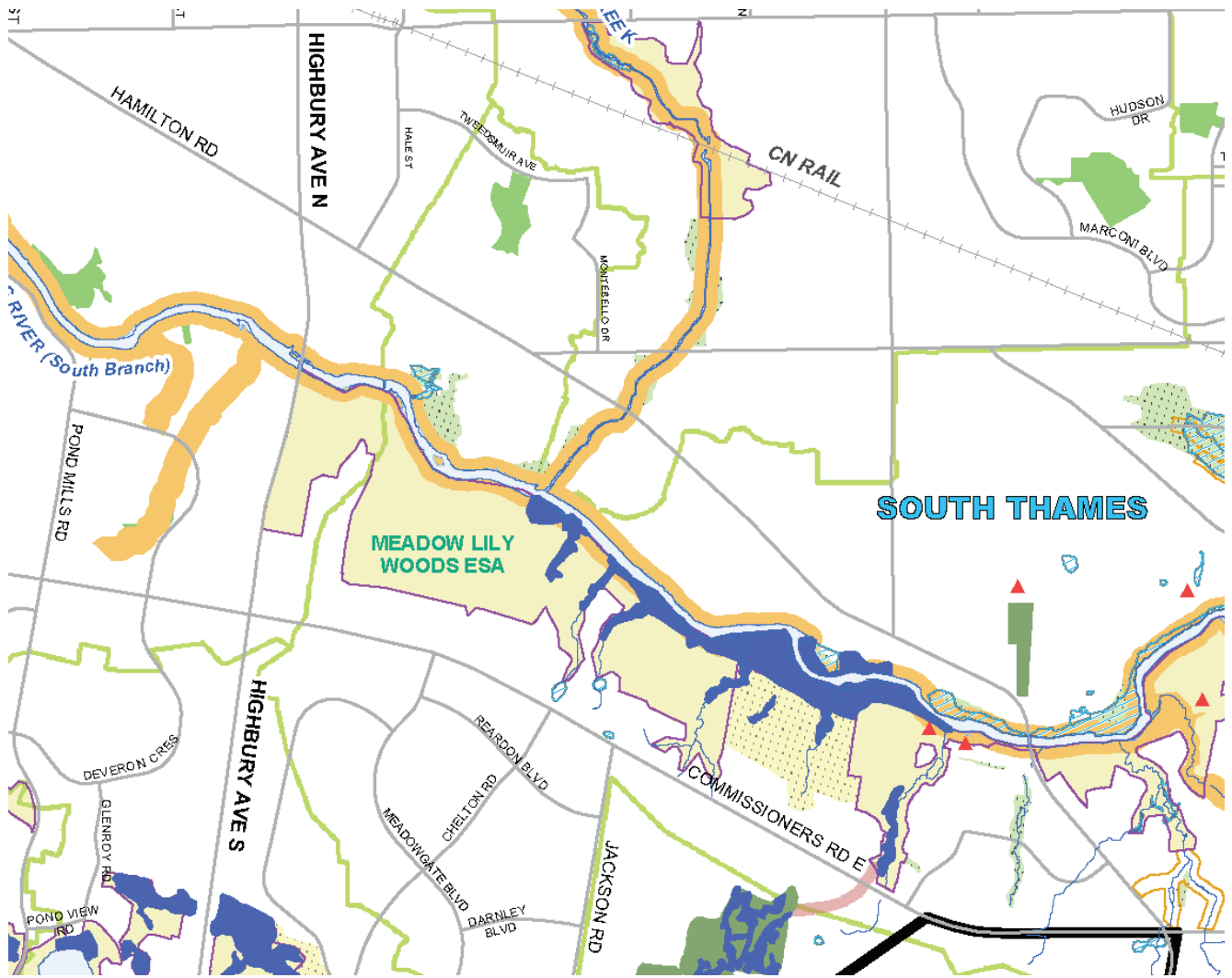
HOW

The Draft Meadowlily Woods ESA Conservation Master Plan, Phase I is consistent with the London Plan, the Environmental Management Guidelines, the London Invasive Plant Management Strategy and the Guidelines for Management Zones and Trails in ESAs. The City of London is an identified leader among other municipalities and other levels of government in demonstrating a proactive approach to the management of invasive species. London is the first city in Ontario to adopt a city-wide invasive plant management strategy, and was recognized with a Conservation award from Ontario Nature for its commitment to protecting ESAs.
