Remember to be safe and follow physical distancing rules.

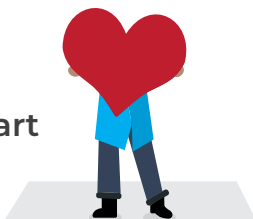
For young kids, scavenger hunts may be best done on foot.
