



Garden Registration Information 2017

If you are interested in a garden plot, send an email to communitygardens@london.ca and share:

- 1) Name of the garden of your choice (see complete list below),
- 2) Your name & home address including postal code,
- 3) Home telephone number and email address.

Please note: Gardeners have the option to come back the following season. If they decide not to return, their plot is assigned to the first person on the waiting list.

Gardeners are responsible for opening their garden plots up in the spring and putting their plot “to bed” in the fall.

Plots are rented on a geared-to-income basis, which allows them to be affordable to all. The rental fee ranges from \$15 to \$40 for a plot of approximately 150-square feet for the season. Plots may vary slightly in size.

The fee structure is based on a total combined household annual income of:

- Up to \$15,000: \$15
- \$16,000 – \$20,000: \$25
- \$21,000 – \$24,000: \$35
- Over \$24,000: \$40

Berkshire Park Community Garden	510 Berkshire Dr.	Located at 510 Berkshire Drive behind the Sifton Clubhouse. This garden was developed in 2009 and is part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone F
Meredith Park Community Garden	450 Nelson St.	Located in the neighbourhood know as SOHO on City land. This garden was established at the beginning of the 2008 growing season and is part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site. Dillabough Community Garden	58 Dillabough St.	This garden was established in 2008 and is part of London's Community Garden Network. The garden can be found at the end of Dillabough Street, with a short walk down a paved path to an open green space. Water is generously donated by Madame Vanier Children's Centre and gardeners fill rain barrels located throughout the garden to ensure access to water during the garden season. Thames Park Community Garden	15 Ridout St. London	Located at Thames Park 25 Ridout Street South on City land. The garden has been in operation since 1999. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone F
University Heights Park Community Garden	290 Trott Dr.	Located at University Heights Park 290 Trott Drive on City land. The garden has been in operation since 2001 and is part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone B

Reservoir Community Garden	552 Crestwood Dr.	Located at 552 Crestwood Dr on City land. The largest community garden site in London's Community Garden network, this garden has been in operating since the early 1990's. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site. Carling Heights Optimist Community Garden	656 Elizabeth St.	Located at 656 Elizabeth Street beside the Carling Heights Optimist Community Centre, this garden has been in operation since 2006. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site. A garden shed is on site, donated by the London North Rotary Club and there is an on-site compost bin for gardeners to use.	Schedule – Zone C
Meadowlily Community Garden	1510 Commissioners Rd E.	Located behind the parking lot for City Wide Sports Park. The garden has been in operation since 2001 and is part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone E
Glen Cairn Community Garden	410 Scenic Dr.	Located at the corner of Scenic Drive and Dover Place on City land. The garden has been in operation since 2001 and is part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by the City of London and stored in a large water tank on site.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone E
Ann Street Park Community Garden	65 Ann St.	Located on City land at the end of Ann Street off Talbot, south of Oxford Street, this garden has been in operation since 2003. Ann Garden's water is supplied by the city of London and stored in large water tanks onsite.	Picked up by City of London Parks and Rec Staff

Blackfriars Community Garden	2 St Patrick St.	Located on City land at the end of St. Patrick Street off Wharncliffe Road North, this garden has been in operation since 1999 and is part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by a neighbour and the City of London pays for the water used during the garden season.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone F
River Forks Park Community Garden	17 Becher St.	Established in 2009, this garden is on City land nestled close to the scenic Forks of the Thames. Water is supplied by a neighbour and the City of London pays for the water used during the garden season.	Picked up by City of London Parks and Rec Staff
Proudfoot Park Community Garden	693 Proudfoot Lane	Located at 693 Proudfoot Lane east of the Costco store on Wonderland Road North. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site.	City Waste Pick-up Schedule – Zone B
Ed Blake Community Garden	Mody Ct, London, ON N5Y 5B6	Located off Barker St. north of Huron St, Ed Blake Community Garden is the newest part of London's Community Garden Network. Water is supplied by the City of London with running water on site.	Schedule – Zone C
