WORK PROGRESS

Rain continued throughout the month of June but the contractors were diligent to keep the project on schedule even though a substantial amount of work occurred on the roof. The contractors are working hard to close the building in to seal the water out and continue progress on the interior. Although the rain slowed interior progress as well, the water was kept at the low parts of the building, in the arena rinks 1 and 2.

The second floor Multi-Purpose Rooms wing opened up for the mason providing for a large amount of interior concrete block work to occur on the second floor. This is being followed by interior metal stud installation to provide shape to the spaces and a perception of the interior spaces of the community centre.

The exterior of the building continued to be closed in with the backup substrate in anticipation of the exterior brick cladding and curtain wall glass to begin shortly.
