Re: Blackfriars Bridge Rehabilitation - Bridge Removal Notice

This notice is provided to nearby residents as additional information about upcoming construction activities.

Work is ongoing for the rehabilitation of Blackfriars Bridge. The next stage involves the removal of the existing bridge in two pieces and temporarily placing one half of the bridge on each of the east and west sides of the Thames River. The bridge will then be further disassembled and transported off site to a shop where the repairs will take place.

The two cranes that will lift the bridge are large and require multiple truckloads of components for assembly and again for disassembly once the lift is completed. You will note increased truck traffic in the area over the next few weeks.

In order to provide room for the cranes to operate during the lift and for pathway users safety, the **Thames Valley Parkway will be temporarily closed to all traffic** starting today.

Once the lift commences, the contractor may potentially be working 24 hours a day for multiple days and during this time there will be increased lighting and noise.
