

Construction Update: Hamilton Road and Sackville Street Reconstruction Project


To: Business owner, resident and/or property owner

The City of London will be coming back to your area to complete work on Hamilton Road and Sackville Street. It is anticipated that the contractor will be starting the week of April 8, 2019, and completing their work by July 2019.

Work To Be Completed:

- Completion of underground work on Sackville
- Boulevard restoration and streetscaping
- Removal of temporary sidewalks
- Completion of new sidewalk
- Completion of the Trafalgar Parkette
- Raised manhole lids
- Final asphalt layer
- Line painting and signage
- Final cleanup

Project Location: The map below shows the construction project limits. Work will occur on Hamilton Street from Egerton Street to Chesley Avenue, and on Sackville from Hamilton Street to 50 metres north of Ormsby Street.



Construction Impacts:

Accessibility

Residents who require accommodation (level entry, advanced notice, etc.) must contact the Consultant or City Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.

Pedestrians

A hard surface will be maintained to allow for sidewalk access the maximum extent possible. Where applicable, signage will be erected on site at either end of the work indicating that the sidewalk is closed to alert pedestrians to find an alternate route.

Motorists

In order to complete the work in a safe manner lanes on Hamilton Road will be channelled during construction. Additionally, Sackville Street will be closed to facilitate underground work. Smith Street and Trafalgar Street will remain open from Hamilton Road.

Manholes will be raised and marked in advance of the final asphalt layer. Drivers should use caution when driving around raised manhole lids.



Bike lanes will be closed during construction, as curb lane closures will be required. Cyclists should exercise caution around construction sites and follow all construction signs.
