Dear Property Owner/Resident:


To improve the quality and reliability of your water and sewer infrastructure, the City of London is planning on reconstructing Dundas Street from Adelaide Street North to Ontario Street in 2020. The Old East Village Secondary Plan and the East-West Bikeway Evaluation will be utilized as building blocks for the streetscape design.

In the coming months City staff and consultants will be on your street drilling test holes, assessing trees, videotaping the street, and testing in some homes with dye to locate sewer connections. You may also see lines painted on the road and yard, which are 'locates' used to identify existing underground pipes and infrastructure.
